

## PROCEDURES TO PROPERLY BURY A VAULT

### Vault Dimensions:

### Minimum Grave Dimensions:

Endurance:

93”L x 36”W x 57”D

Eonian:

93”L x 36”W x 57” D

Infant Casket Vault

Small:

26”L x 14”W x 30” D

Large:

36”L x 18”W x 36” D

Urn Vault:

18”L x 18”W x 36”D

STEP 1 - Excavate gravesite to dimensions listed above.

STEP 2 - Lower vault and fill sides and ends of hole by shoveling and make sure soil surrounds vault.

STEP 3 – Fill grave to ground level. POWER TAMP grave, sides and ends should be traveled twice and one trip up and down center of vault. The more you use the power tamp the better. Our vault will not fail.

STEP 4 – Fill to ground level and repeat POWER TAMP procedure. The more you use the power tamp the better. Our vault will not fail.

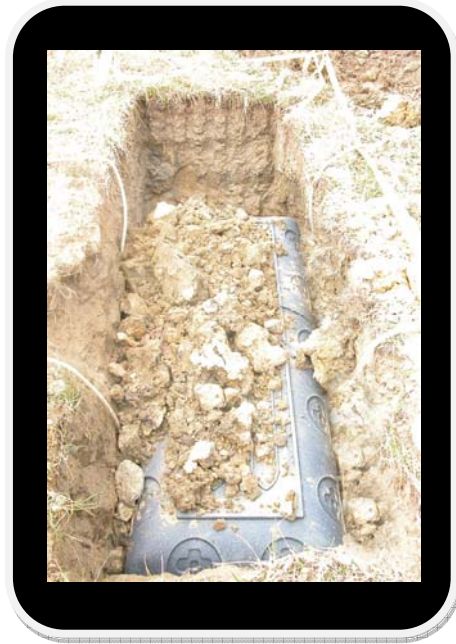
STEPS 5 – To finish add loose soil to bring the grave level with surrounding grade, seed and straw or replace sod.

The procedures stated above will result in a superior grave that will not require return trips or nervousness associated with sunken graves as occurs with mounding practices.
